We will be using Class Dojo as a reward system for the class. It is an interactive resource where children can accumulate dojo points for different aspects of their work e.g. being on task, great answers, changing reading books regularly, handing homework in early.

Children will collect the points and when they reach a certain amount they can be converted into house points for their team colour.



Homework

Homework will be given out on Fridays to be returned, completed, on or before the following Wednesday to allow marking and preparation for new homework.

Homework handed in on a Monday will be awarded extra Dojo points.

There will normally be an English and Mathematics activity. Please talk about the homework and encourage your child to complete it as independently as possible.

If your child would like to bring in any books, pictures, photographs or artefacts on our topic they would be most welcome.

Spelling and Reading

Spellings will be sent home with homework on Fridays. They will be tested the following Wednesday. Please encourage your child to complete the 'Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check' sheet to help with learning.

Reading is very important. We read in class on a daily basis and encourage the children to regularly read at home. Reading books and reading records can be checked and changed on any day of the week.

We still need the books and reading records to be brought into school even if the book is not finished so we can keep our records up to date.
