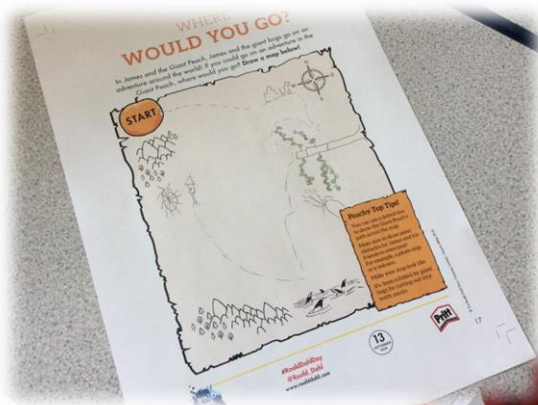
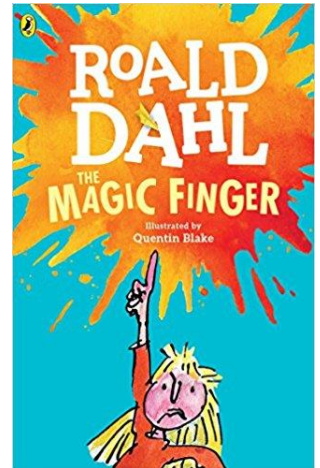




Roald Dahl Day

13th September

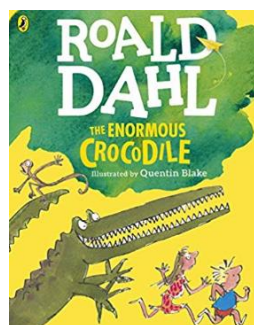
Rowan Class had a great day celebrating Roald Dahl Day on 13th September 2018

Rowan Class loved watching The Enormous Crocodile.

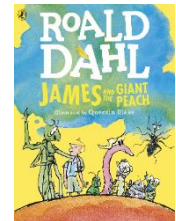


Thank you to Willoughby Foods for our wonderful lunch.
